Peek at the Week

This week we are back to having reading groups 3x weekly. Please record on the back of the book the pages your child read at home for the assignment. Your child is not to read any further than what we have read in class.

We will learn the long sound of each vowel.

We will introduce the two-vowel rule:

"When there are two vowels in a word, the first vowel says its long sound; the second one is silent." Please review this with your child. It is important in the reading process.

In numbers, the 5-addition family will be introduced. Ordinal numbers (6th-10th) are going to be introduced. We are telling stories to illustrate addition problems.

Looking Ahead

Please start to think about what items you might want to collect for our 100-day celebration. I would like your collection to be displayed on a poster board with 100 items on it. More details will follow.
