Math Test (17) Study Guide



*Practice math facts up to addition family and subtraction family 9.

*Know about inches and centimeters. Know centimeters are smaller than inches!

*Practice counting before and after numbers by 10's.

*Practice counting by two's, five's, and ten's and twenty-fives. Especially by two's!

*Practice counting money, all coins including the quarter.

*Practice story problems. Remember to keep the order of the sentence and to give the answer then the number sentence.

*Practice adding three numbers together, such as $4+1+2=7$.
