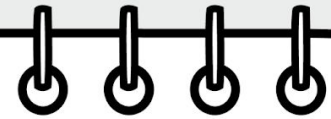
A Peek at The Week

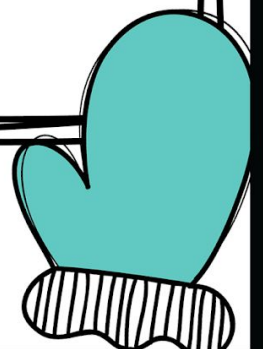

Math Test (18) Study Guide

- Practice Math facts up to addition family 10 and subtraction family 9.
- Review measurements: inches, foot, centimeters, dozen, minutes, etc.
- Review telling time.
 - Remember to review the hour, half-hour, 15 minutes past, and 45 or quarter 'till.
- Review story problems. Use daily work papers as a guide.
- Review counting from 121-191
- Review counting by 2's, 3's & 5's

Phonics Test (18) Study Guide

- Practice all spelling words (list 16: a, the, come, I, you, of, one, two, what, was, said, have, give, do, to.)
- Practice circling special sounds marking vowels and reading the following words:
 - torn wink munch wood baby born pink lunch
tooth purple song link
- Practice blends similar to the following (make sure to practice both with using both long and short vowel sounds):
 - che shu sta stra squa
- Practice charts 8-10
- Practice sounds like wa in wash, ank in bank, unk in trunk, ar in star, ong in strong. Practice using other words for the clue words such as wa in wasp, instead of wash. We are learning to apply the sounds/clue words in other words. The Handbook (HB) is very helpful for this!
