VOCABULARY - MARINE GEOLOGY

hydrosphere - all water on Earth, whether liquid, solid, or gas

oceanography - study of the ocean

salinity - saltiness

tributary - stream that empties into a river and joins its course

drainage basin - land drained by a river; watershed

continental divide - drainage divide at which two major river systems flow into different oceans

aquifer - layer of rock that holds water

drainage divide - high ridge that separates two river systems

continental divide - drainage divide at which two major river systems flow into different oceans

wave - back-and-forth movement that transfers energy

tsunami - enormous wave caused by an earthquake on the ocean floor

tide - daily predictable movement of the ocean caused by the moon's gravitational pull

shore - land along the edge of the ocean

estuary - body of water where the river meets the ocean; contains brackish water

sandbar - offshore ridge made of sand and other sediments

ooze - type of seafloor mud made from minerals and the remains of tiny ocean organisms

seamount - underwater volcanic mountain

rift - valley where the oceanic crust seems to be separating

high tide - when the ocean tide is at the highest point

low tide - when the ocean tide is at the lowest point
