This week we are back to having reading groups 3x weekly. Please remember to listen to your child read the assigned pages; then record the assigned pages read on the back of the reading book.

We are introducing the two-vowel rule: "When there are two vowels in a word, the first vowel says its long sound; the second one is silent." Please review this with your child.

In numbers, we are reviewing the 4 Addition Family; the 5 Addition Family will be introduced. We are telling stories to illustrate addition problems.
